

SCCA-CPR Drivers Meeting



General Items

- Everybody must sign the waiver and wear a wristband. If you do not have a wristband please see waivers.
- Keep speeds in the paddock, grid, and elsewhere on the event site at a walking pace.
- Site-specific dos and don'ts
 - No speeding in park
 - No tire warming
- Weather-related precautions - drink plenty of water, if it's hot, wear sunscreen, tie down your EZUps if it's windy
- We'll suspend the event if there's lightning in the area.
- Smoking/Vaping/E-Cig is not allowed in the active grid or within 25 feet of the building.
- Children under 12 and pets are not allowed in grid or course areas with the exception of Junior Kart drivers when they're running. Pets must be on a leash at all times.
- Alcohol and drugs are strictly prohibited before and during the event.
- Passengers – 12 and up must have a signed waiver.
- No hand-held cameras - arms and hands inside the vehicle at all times.
- We have a limited number of helmets - they go to competitors first, please see waivers to sign out a helmet.
- Designated spectator locations – Behind the terminal in the fenced in area at the Airport.
- Photographers not allowed on course without SSS approval and adult spotter.
- Once you cross the finish line, your run is over. Get on the brakes. Cones after the finish count as a DNF.
- Don't be a hero. If you spin out, put both feet in (brake and clutch) to the floor and get your car gathered back up before you continue.
- If you see a red flag waiving while you're on-course, STOP. Wait until a course worker tells you to proceed.
